Working together to plan for your next steps after high school.

1. I will plan for our meetings and ask you to take away from our meetings what you will need to be successful on this journey. This may be a timeline for you to complete applications, searches, extracurricular activities and all of the things that will help you to be a successful candidate for the colleges on your list.
 2. Meetings are typically 50 minutes to an hour.
 3. The needs of each grade level are very different.
 4. College 101 – 9th grade / from 1 time a semester to once a month
 5. College 102- 10th grade/ from 2 or 3 times a semester to twice a month
 6. College 103- 11th grade/ 1 or 2 times a month* see below.
 7. College 104- 12th grade/ Usually 2 times or more a month* see below.
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- 11th and 12th grade – These are crucial to your success in college admissions. Please see other areas of the website for what is accomplished in these two grade levels.
 - The summer is also a time when both grade levels should be thinking ahead.
 1. 11th grade will be working on goals for the summer before the senior year. Typically one or two sessions will be important.
 2. 12th grade will want to schedule summer sessions as needed to be prepared to apply during first semester senior year.

Once the consult is completed, services are structured and fee schedules are explained. CPS endeavors to make the cost for you very affordable with the best cost being that for a semester. It is based on your grade level and the services we together feel would be right for you.

The consult fee is standard for all, but the time we spend working together will be different and is actually less the more time we spend together.
